Dear Parents and Carers of Children in Year 6

On Monday 2nd October, year 6 pupils have the opportunity to go to Newhaven Fort to attend an event called Safety in Action. Children from over 20 primary schools in the Lewes district will have the chance to test their skills in an emergency during Safety in Action Week. The week is organised jointly by East Sussex Fire and Rescue, Sussex Police, Ambulance Service, Southern Rail and aims to teach children from school year 6 how to deal with different safety scenarios in relation to fires, accidents, electricity, dogs, strangers, water safety, roads and internet safety. Schools will be divided into work groups to rotate round the different 'action stations'. They will be given scores according to how best they deal with an imaginary situation.

Safety in Action is free. Children will need to be prepared for the weather as part of it will be held outside, so a raincoat, sunhat, suntan lotion etc would be needed. They need to wear full school uniform and sensible, comfortable footwear. The event is for the morning only, please would you drop your child at the fort by 9.15am we will bring the children back to school by minibus in time for their lunch.
