#### Uniform Reminder

Thank you for sending children in smart school uniform in accordance with our policy. This is available on the website.

#### Head Lice

This week we have had a couple of cases of head lice reported in school. Please make a point of checking your child's hair regularly and if you find evidence of an infestation please treat accordingly.

Regular daily combing with a louse or nit comb can clear lice infestations. A bright light and a magnifying glass are needed and the combing has to go on until no living lice have been found for two weeks. Lubricating the hair with a conditioner (wet combing) makes the procedure easier, particularly for curly hair. The comb has to be immediately cleaned after each pass to remove lice and eggs. This is best done by wiping on clean white paper or cloth.
