

<u>I like reading and writing</u>	Write an acrostic poem for a planet of your choice. Research the planet to make sure the words and phrases you choose describe the planet.	Write a space adventure theme story. Remember to make your story exciting!
<u>I enjoy maths</u>	Design a rocket and price each component (at least 5). Find the total cost of your rocket.	Create a poster showing the names and relative sizes of the planets in the solar system.
<u>I like researching and finding things out.</u>	Create a moon diary. Look at the moon every night for 4 days in a row, draw what it looks like each night. How does it change?	Find out about the zodiac star constellation for your birth date. Could you draw it and record some facts about it?
<u>I like to make things and be creative.</u>	Create a vehicle that you could use to travel into space. What would it look like? You could create a rocket using cardboard tubes, a spacecraft using old boxes, or you could design a different type of vehicle to get you there!	
	Can you draw and label 8 planets? You could make a model of our solar system with paper mache or materials from your recycling.	Make your own 3D alien! You can use whichever materials you choose.
<u>I like to draw and paint.</u>	We all need to be protected from work that is dangerous. Draw a picture of an astronaut. Can you label the different parts of the clothing that they need to wear?	Can you draw a picture of space using only 2D shapes? Can you name the shapes you have used in your picture?
