Dear Parents and Carers,

Given the unprecedented change to our school year we thought it would be useful to give you a brief update of the work going on to support our schools. Changes have taken place at such speed that I'm sure, like us, you're still getting used to them. Please give yourselves time to adjust and remember that our health and well-being is our current priority.

Some of you will be using our hub school at Ringmer but the majority of us are staying home and beginning to find our way with home learning. We would like to thank you all for your support of our staff at this time. Virtual teaching and learning is new for our schools and we are all finding our feet! We are exceptionally grateful to our dedicated staff who have undertaken change at remarkable speed and are volunteering to staff the hub school during this time.

Governing during school closures

The board has agreed a remote governing policy which allows us to maintain our responsibilities with the current school closures. We had a virtual full governing board the final week of school, which covered the procedures for closing our schools and creating a hub school for children of key workers, who had no available childcare at home. We confirmed our operational plans should our senior leaders become ill and we have agreed an informal arrangement with our local primary schools for Head Teachers and Chairs of Governors should this be required. The board also agreed our Executive Head Teacher and Chair of Governors have the authority to make decisions in an exceptional circumstance which requires immediate action before the board can be formed.


