


Dear Parents and Carers,

WOODLAND TRUST, TREES FOR SCHOOLS

We are very lucky to have been successful in our application to the Woodland Trust for Trees for School. They



are letting us have, free of charge, 105 saplings including these species: rowan, silver birch, wild cherry, common oak, field maple, grey willow. Firle Estate have kindly let us use some land next to the nature reserve to plant our trees which will replace those lost in the devastating storm of 1987. We will be letting you have more details of our planting event nearer the time as we would like to get everyone involved, including all in the village.

PROCEDURES FOR BAD WEATHER

Please can you make sure that your child/ren have a coat every day for school as we go out in all weathers. They are also able to wear tracksuit bottoms for PE in the winter months.
