<p>What happens?</p> <p>The women visit the tomb and find it empty. They meet two angels who tell them Jesus has risen from the dead.</p> <p>What is the significance of this? What does it show about Jesus?</p> <p>Points could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It shows Jesus has the power of life over death. • The presence of the angels show he is a holy being. 	<p>What happens?</p> <p>Jesus appears to two of his followers. They do not seem to believe what they have been told about his resurrection. Jesus tells them they are mistaken and that he has risen. It is only then that they recognise Jesus.</p> <p>What is the significance of this? What does it show about Jesus?</p> <p>Points could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It shows Jesus has the power of life over death. • It shows that his resurrection is crucial in Christian thinking. It is proof of their faith. 	<p>What happens?</p> <p>Jesus appears to the remaining apostles and tells them to go out and preach his message. He then ascends in to heaven.</p> <p>What is the significance of this? What does it show about Jesus?</p> <p>Points could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ascension shows Jesus is God and part of the Trinity. • It inspires the start of Christianity as the apostles go out and preach. • God gives them power/encouragement to preach. 	<p>What happens?</p> <p>Thomas, one of the apostles, doubts the stories of Jesus' resurrection. Jesus appears to him and lets him see the wounds he has suffered yet has overcome through resurrection. Thomas then believes.</p> <p>What is the significance of this? What does it show about Jesus?</p> <p>Points could include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • It shows Jesus has the power of life over death. • Students may mention the 'Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe' line as encouragement for Christians to have faith.
