<u>I like reading and writing</u>	Write a short story or comic strip about a superhero - it could be a superhero we all know or a made up one. It could even be about you!		A day in the life of... Write a secret diary; describe a day in your life as a superhero. What is a day at school like for you? How do you use your super powers? Does anyone know you are a super hero? What is it really like being a superhero?
<u>I enjoy maths</u>		Create a recipe for a superhero power potion. Make sure you tell people how much of each ingredient to use.	Write some of your own word problems about superheroes for your friends to have a go at answering. E.g. if superman saved 10 people one day and 6 another, how many people would he have saved altogether.  TEN LITTLE SUPERHEROES
<u>I like researching and finding things out.</u>	Research a famous superhero and write a fact file about them or create a poster that describes the superhero of your choice. 	Find out about or talk to a real-life superhero (e.g. a doctor). What can you find out about their job? Who do you see as your superhero? Why are they a superhero to you? Write about this and add illustrations to your writing.	
<u>I like to make things and be creative.</u>	Design and make a superhero gadget, what does it do? Does it help your hero? Make sure you label your design and photograph any of your creations. Design / make a meal fit for a superhero to give them lots of energy for their missions. Take photographs of this to share with your friends.		
<u>I like to draw and paint.</u>	Choose your favourite superhero and design a new outfit for them. Label your design and tell us why you've made the choices you have.
