Could we please take this opportunity to remind all parents that we are a <u>nut free school</u> and as a result, nuts and any foods containing nuts are not allowed in school. Please bear this in mind when making packed lunches, snacks.

Could we also remind you that KS2 children are allowed to bring in snack for playtime but this must only be either a piece of fruit or vegetable sticks e.g. carrot sticks, pepper, cucumber. Please avoid fruit based items such as winders or fruit yo-yos. Finally, could we remind you not to put chocolate bars or sweets into packed lunches- chocolate biscuit products e.g. Penguins are fine. Generally, as a rule of thumb, items in the biscuit aisle are fine; however, items in the confectionary aisle should not be included.


