

EYFS Framework – 3 Prime Areas of Learning and 4 specific areas underpinned by four

Prime Area: Communication & Language

- Listen attentively to what is being read and to class

Prime Area: Physical Development

- Use a tripod grip when holding a pencil to form letters correctly and show accuracy and detail

Prime Area: Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- WWO – (Working with Others):- problem solving

Literacy: Comprehension, Word Reading and Writing

Texts:- Non-fiction (schools, transport, shops etc in the past)
Fiction:- traditional tales/stories handed down through the generations (eg Goldilocks/Three Little Pigs/Jack and the Beanstalk/Three Billy Goats Gruff);
